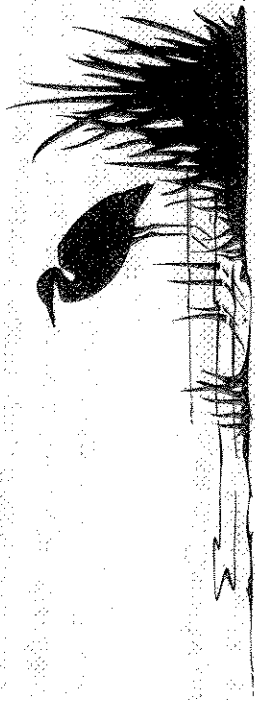


Directions

Cross the Bay Bridge onto the Eastern Shore
Stay on Rt 50 (towards Ocean City)
You will pass through Easton and Cambridge and
be heading toward Salisbury
Before coming into Salisbury, take the expressway
around Salisbury (Rt 50 and Rt 13 together)
Once on the south side of Salisbury, continue
on Rt 13 toward Princess Anne and
Pocomoke City and the Virginia state line
5 miles across the state line, turn left onto Rt 175
After crossing a series of bridges over marsh and
channels, you will come onto the Island of
Chincoteague
Turn left at the traffic light (Main Street)
Make a right onto Maddox Blvd
Continue on Maddox as you drive halfway
around the traffic circle
Dove Winds is located beside Dolle's (Pony Tails)
store (both are easily seen from the traffic
circle)
You may park behind Dove Winds
near the blue and yellow houses
